DESCRIPTION

Superb "Grand Banks" built in 1980. This boat is made for those who also love to cruise on the sea. You will be her design and impressed by how well built it is. The interior is bright and comfortable to live in. There is a spacious living room, leading to the galley, with an interior steering position, two cabins and two bathrooms.

COMFORT

Sleeps 4 to 6 people, 2 cabins. 2 electric toilets. 2 showers. Radio and CD player. TV antenna. 2 x 2000W electric radiators. 50L 220V and engine hot water boiler. Gas hob. Gas oven. Microwave oven. 12V fridges. Freezer fridge.

2 steering positions. Hydraulic gangplank. Swimpladder. Swimplatform. Bimini top. Mast. Horn. Searchlight. Davits. Quick electric anchor winch, chain length approximately 50m. Deck shower. Navigation lights. Windscreen wipers. Teak deck. Zodiac dinghy from 2020. Yamaha 4,5hp OB engine. Plastimo lifeboat. Automatic fire extinguisher in the engine room to be revised. Raymarine GPS, chartplotter, radar and speedometer. Echosounder. Anemometer. Navicom VHF. Autopilot. Compass.

TECHNICAL

2 x 210hp Caterpillar engines. Sidepower bowthruster. Electric bilge pump. Manual bilge pump. 2 sets of 4 x 200ah batteries from 2021. Onan 6kva Diesel soundproof generator. Victron 12V 80A battery charger. Victron 2000W inverter. 200W solar panel. Last hull painting under water in June 2021.

TANKAGE

2500L engine fuel in 2 tanks. 1000L fresh water in 2 tanks. Black water tank evacuation pump.
