BRIDGE

Steering position. Bimini top. Mast. In-mast furling mainsail. Genoa sail. Mizzen sail. Cruising chute sail. Horn. Anchor winch, chain length approximately 60m. Navigation lights. Bombard inflatable dinghy with 4,5hp OB engine. Garmin GPS with chartplotter. Echosounder. Speedometer. VHF. Raymarine autopilot. Plastimo compass.

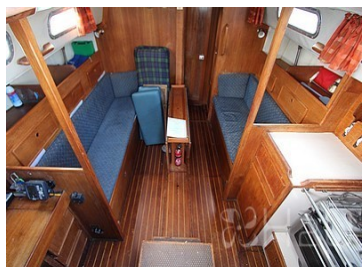

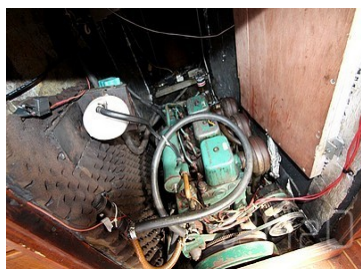
